School Improvement Plan Goals:

New Business:

Ms. Turner presented the Instructional Reivew Data that was conducted on 1/19/16 to a committee of educators within Orange County Public Schools. Key points were made to the SAC committee.

- Fall Benchmark Results indicate reading proficiency of each grade level based on standards taught in the first nine weeks.
- Summative Results indicate proficiency on specific standards taught after each unit. Theses results help intervene and differentiate in small groups within the classroom.
- AdvancED Survey results from the 2014-2015 school year provide Riverdale Elementary with staff, student, and parent opinions about what is working. Additionally, the survey results provide areas of opportunity and improvement.
 - Items to build upon and action steps implemented this year as a result.
 - Staff- services that meet the physical, social, and emotional needs of students- New Mentoring Program, Restructuring of MTSS process, PBS & Student Recognition
 - Parents- activities for students to participate- after school enrichment clubs, journalism club, drum corps
 - Students- my family likes to come to school- engaging family and academic nights (including prizes and food), class meetings

Ms. Turner then presented the SIP to the committee.

- Two goals on the SIP, each goal has a barrier (voted by staff and SAC committee in August)
- Goals plus the barrier= a strategy to overcome the barrier and action steps that the school will take
- Committee will continue to review the SIP for the remainder of the year
- Annual targets for FSA Reading, FSA Math, and FCAT Science will not remain the same as indicated on the SIP (increase)
